

UNRAVELING A FUTURE SCENE

FPS/Curricular Connection:

To explore a future scene and fully understand its components
To help teams make the links between their research, the future scene, and the initial steps of the problem solving process

Intended Audience:

All Levels

Materials:

One large sheet of paper (A2 or butcher's paper) per team
One copy of the future scene for each person, plus one pasted on the chart (See Figure one.)
Highlighter pens and felt pens (markers) for each group

Suggested Time:

- One hour


Procedures:

1. Rule up the large piece of paper as shown in the diagram (Fig. One).
2. Paste (glue) one copy of the future scene on the sheet of paper as shown and write in headings. This can be photocopied and expanded to A3 (i.e. the largest size possible).
3. Ask students to read their own copy of the future scene, highlight relevant parts, and discuss it with their team.
4. As they discuss, the team members make notes under the appropriate headings on the chart and can draw arrows back to the appropriate parts of the future scene.
5. If you are working with more than one team, give them an opportunity to discuss their charts when they have finished.

Comments:

This activity works best with teams and coaches who are already familiar with Future Problem Solving.
