

Scenario Performance (ScP) Competition Information

LIVE at International Conference 2019

Now that registration for IC 2019 is complete, the detailed information in this correspondence will help all Scenario Performance competitors prepare for the live performance at International Conference 2019. The Scenario Performance competition will take place before a live audience either the afternoon or evening, as scheduled, on Friday, June 7th. Due to a large number of Senior division participants they will have a final round on Saturday, June 8th. Coaches with questions about the competition should contact Brad Persinger (brad@fpspi.org).

Each competitor should incorporate a sub-topic of the IC Topic into his/her performance: As in other Future Problem Solving components, research on the topic, De-Extinction, will be very helpful as competitors prepare their performance. Each competitor will choose one of the following sub-topics to incorporate into his/her performance:

- The ethics of De-Extinction
- Views from different perspectives (Example: biologists vs. conservationists)
- Technology's role in resurrection biology
- Systems used to monitor resurrected animals/plants
- Environmental impact of species reintroduction
- Living among De-Extinct species

Alternative Option: Scenario performers may submit alternative sub-topic ideas on De-Extinction for approval to Brad Persinger (brad@fpspi.org) by May 23rd.

GUIDELINES:

1. Scenario Performance specifications:
 - a. Performances will be timed. Each performer will have up to 5 minutes to perform his/her scenario. At the 5 minute mark, the performance will be called to an end.
 - b. The performance will include only the voice and hand movements of the competitor. A microphone will be provided. Props, physical "acting" and/or computer background/slideshows will **not** be permitted.
 - c. A performer may sit or stand – this is a personal preference.
 - d. Cue cards created by performers will be permitted (limit of 10 cards sized 4"x 6" or A6 metric).
2. Judging of the live performances:
 - a. Judges will be present for the live performances.
 - b. Video-taping will occur for review, later reference, and promotional purposes.
3. Awarding of champions:

A champion will be named and an award presented in all participating divisions during Sunday's Award Ceremony.
