### Virtual IC Plan

#### Updates for Virtual IC

- Competition will be individual rather than team.
- Students will have an alternate Future Scene, so if they wish to compete in GIPS on June 5-6, they may do so.
- Award Ceremony: Conducted via Facebook Live on Tuesday, June 9.

#### Timeline

- **Monday, May 25:** Contract will be emailed to competitors stating that work will be their own and that they are the only writers and editors of their Scenarios
- **Monday, June 1:** Instructions and Future Scene will be released at 8:00am EDT
- **Thursday, June 4:** Scenario must be uploaded into FPSOnline by 12:00pm EDT

#### Requirements

- Students will write a 1500-word or less short story within the Future Scene's parameters of **time, place, and topic**.
- They must submit their Scenario in Word (.doc or .docx) format.
- There must be no identifying information in the Scenario, title, header, file name, etc.
- The file name must have the Scenario code.
- The header must have the title and Scenario code.

## Evaluation

- Evaluations are based on creative and futuristic thinking, idea and character development, style/voice, mechanics, topic related research, and relationship to Future Scene.
- Awards are given for top scoring Scenarios.
