Updates for Virtual IC

- Entries will be submitted as unlisted YouTube links.
- Students will submit these before GIPS competition, so if they wish to compete in GIPS on June 5-6, they may do so.
- Award Ceremony: Conducted via Facebook Live on Tuesday, June 9.

Timeline

- **Monday, May 18: Rules, competitor codes, and instructions for competition will be emailed to competitors, along with topics/themes**
- **Wednesday, June 3: Performance must be submitted via unlisted YouTube link by 12:00pm EDT**

Requirements

- Each competitor should incorporate a sub-topic of the IC Topic into his/her performance; these sub-topics will be released May 18. As in other Future Problem Solving components, research on the topic, Terraforming, will be very helpful as competitors prepare their performance.
- Competitors must submit their Performance as an unlisted YouTube link. The video's title must be the competitor's code, and the performer should hold up a title card with their assigned code at the start of the performance.
- There must be no identifying information in the performance, including the competitor's name or the names of their school, Affiliate, country, state, etc.
- The video must be a single taping with no edits.

Evaluation

- Evaluations are based on storytelling techniques, audience awareness, use of voice, development of story, characterization, creative thinking, relation to topic, and futuristic thinking
- Awards are given for top scoring Scenario Performances in each division.
