



## MAGIC FAQs

**Q:** What is MAGIC?

**A:** Multi-Affiliate Global Issues Problem Solving Competition (MAGIC) is offered **ON-SITE only** for 2022 in the Junior, Middle, and Senior Divisions. MAGIC provides an opportunity for collaboration with other problem-solvers from around the world as competitors are randomly placed by FPSPI onto teams by division.

**Q:** What is included in a MAGIC booklet?

**A:** Eight challenges, eight solution ideas, and a shortened grid will be completed in the MAGIC booklet. MAGIC will have the same 2 hours as GIPS Teams to complete their work. For IC 2022 all MAGIC booklets will be completed using a handwritten booklet.

**Q:** Who is eligible for MAGIC?

**A:** Scenario Writers, Scenario Performers, and others who are not competing in GIPS or CmPS during IC 2022. Participants **MUST** be experienced in GIPS, thus well versed in the problem-solving process. Participants must be able to converse with their team members in English, though the translation of written materials can be arranged. This should be noted during registration.

**Q:** Who will be on my team?

**A:** MAGIC teams are assigned by FPSPI to try and include students from across regions. All students will receive their team assignment after checking-in to their competition room on Thursday June 9.

**Q:** Where do I get my FPSOnline credentials?

**A:** Since all MAGIC booklets will be completed using a handwritten booklet, FPSOnline credentials will not be provided until the conclusion of the on-site MAGIC event. This way students will be able to view their work and score sheets after the conclusion of IC. Coach accounts will not include their MAGIC students.
