



# CmPS Display Details

All competitors will create a Display for their project. The Display should describe the project to the audience (evaluators and the community more generally). It should capture the audience's attention and communicate the project goals and accomplishments. The Display should not need student commentary to present the project. Displays will be scored without students present. A great project may escape attention if key elements are not presented or are lost among extraneous items. Once the setup timeframe has ended, no items may be added or removed from the display.

## SETUP

- Project Display set-up Thursday, June 8, 12:30-4:30 pm as assigned in check-in materials
- FPSPI will provide one tri-fold display board for each project.
  - All provided boards will be a standard size – typically 36”H X 48” W (1.2 m x 91.4 cm).
  - Students may incorporate additional items into their display beyond the provided display board.
  - Creatively enhancing, adapting, and modifying the provided display board is encouraged.
- FPSPI will provide one table for each project.
  - All tables within a division will be the same size.
  - The height of the display from the tabletop may not exceed 50 inches (127cm).
  - An undecorated tablecloth/table skirt may be used.
  - Items visible below or beside the table and/or above the 50-inch (127 cm) limit are not permitted.
  - Students will be asked to remove items that are beyond the designated tabletop space.
- Display items must remain with the project from the end of setup Thursday afternoon, until display removal on Saturday afternoon.
  - Valuable, fragile, or otherwise unnecessary props should not be included.
  - Electronic devices are not prohibited, however access to a power outlet is unlikely.
  - FPSPI is not responsible for any items left unattended as part of a display.
- Display removal is the responsibility of the students, and will be on Saturday afternoon.

NOTE: Displays are evaluated prior to the CmPS Showcase. Additional items used for crowd engagement during the Showcase may be brought for the event.

## REQUIREMENTS

- Project Code placard visible
- Provided display board used
- Height from tabletop does not exceed 50 inches (127 cm)
- Nothing hangs downward from tabletop
- No freestanding or under-table items
- All items are to remain at project display until removal on Saturday afternoon
- Physical portfolio included with Display (if not submitted electronically in advance)
- No valuable, fragile, or unnecessary items in Display area
